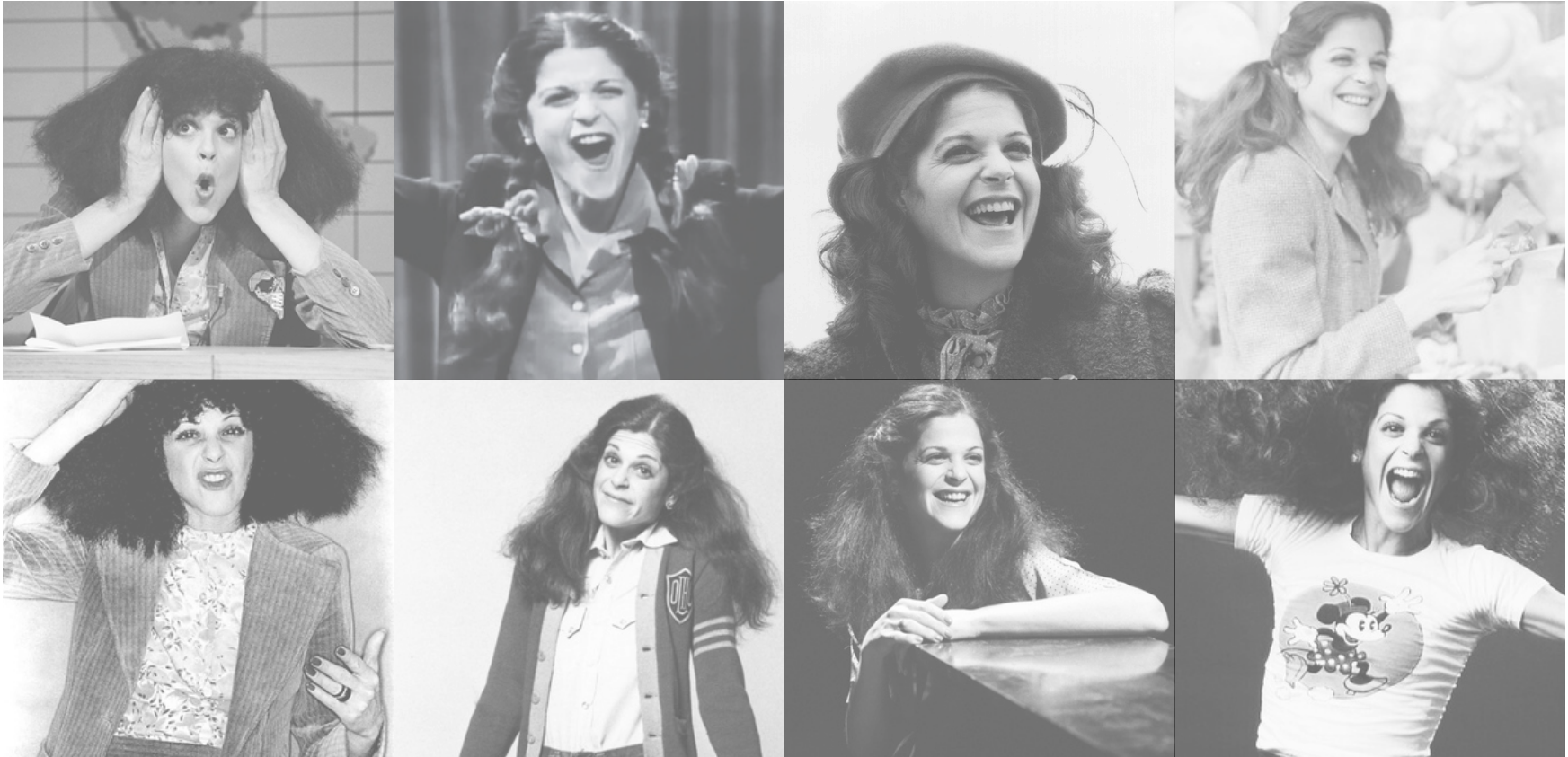

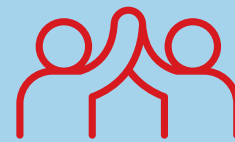




Social Programs

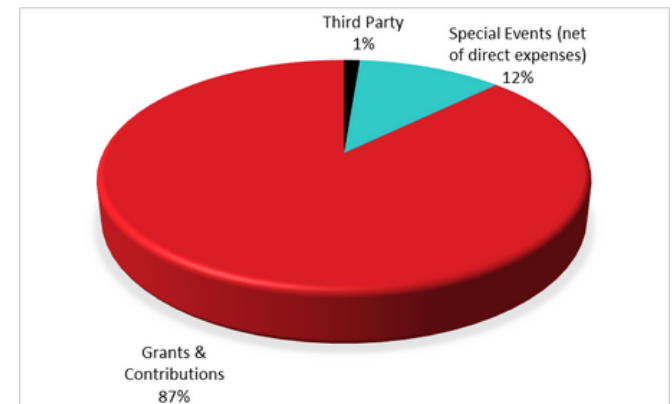
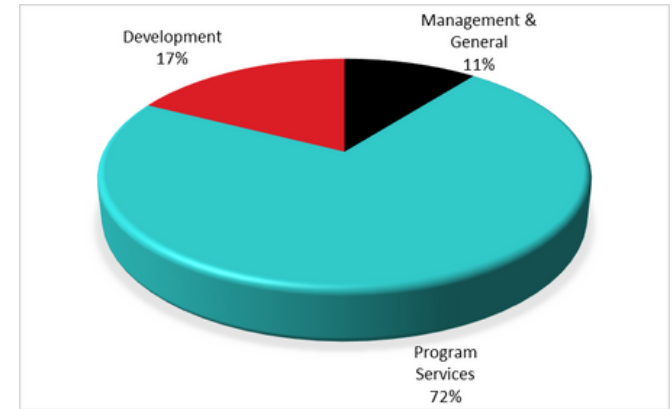
